Subject : Inviting applications for National Handicrafts Awards (Shilp Guru Award & National Award) for the Award Year 2024 under National Handicraft Development Programme (NHDP)

Sir,

As you are aware, that the Office of the Development Commissioner (Handicrafts) confers Handicrafts Awards to artisans for recognition of their contribution towards the growth and development of handicrafts sector. The award, conferred once in a lifetime, encourages them to preserve our old craft-traditions and excellence in craftsmanship. The selection is done by a three-tier selection process viz Regional, Headquarters and Central Level Selection Committees. The Handicrafts Awards 2024 is to be granted in the following two major categories:

- (i) Shilp Guru Handicrafts Award : Six(06) awards
- (ii) National Handicrafts Award : Nineteen(19) awards

2. In this connection, an advertisement, inviting applications from the eligible applicants for selection of Handicrafts Award-2024 (Shilp Guru/National Award) under the National Handicraft Development Programme (NHDP) shall be published in various leading National/Regional Newspapers tentatively on 05.04.2025. The tentative last date of submission of the application form in Handicrafts Service Centre/Regional Office is 05.05.2025. The Handicrafts Award guidelines, schedule of calendar for selection of awards, advertisement is available and uploaded on the official website of the department www.handicrafts.nic.in. A copy of the same is also appended herewith for ready reference.

3. As per the directives contained in Para-4 of the Handicrafts Award guidelines, all Regional Directors and Handicrafts Service Centres are requested to extend all possible support to the eligible artisans/craftperson and ensure wider publicity.

4. Most importantly, the Para 2 of the award guidelines regarding Verification of character & antecedent of the awardee stipulates as under:

"The verification of character & antecedent will be carried out by the Sr. Assistant Director /Asstt. Director (H) of Handicrafts Service Centre through the concerned agency before recommending the application to Regional Level Selection Committee for consideration. Regional Director may ascertain of verification of the character antecedent before recommending the applications to Headquarter office or if the report is awaited from the concerned authority, a certificate may be given that the report is awaited and would be forwarded later on.

5. Regarding write up of the artifact it is submitted that during scrutinization of the bio data applications for the last year award selection process the content of the write up was not in order and some of them were also handwritten which was not legible. The concerned HSCs should ensure the utmost care while accepting the award applications from the artisans with proper write up. A copy of the format of write up is attached alongwith this letter which is a part of the application form.

6. Apart from accepting the offline applications, all Assistant Directors of HSCs and Regional Directors have to provide complete assistance to artisans in filling up of online applications for Handicrafts Award, 2024. It is pertinent to mention that the MIS Nodals have successfully submitted the test run applications of award on MIS portal and the portal is live for submission of award applications. It is mandatory for the artisans to apply online and a copy of the online application should be attached with the bio data before recommending to RLSC.

7. In view of the above, all Regional Directors are kindly requested to initiate the process of executing the invitation of applications via online and offline modes, preparation of Regional Level Selection Committee (RLSC) meetings and after the completion of the RLSC meetings the minutes of the meeting alongwith consolidated marksheet, reason of rejection (if any) and application form (Bio Data) of the recommended artisans may be sent to Welfare Division. All the details of the artisan such as name of the craft, name of the main category and name of the sub category needs to be cross checked and verified. The applications would be invited in accordance to the revised craft category of 455 crafts list circulated by Hqrs office vide letter No.K-12012/1/5/2024-25/R&D dated 15.10.2024 (copy enclosed). A copy of the proposed timeline activities regarding Handicrafts Award, 2024 is appended herewith at Annexure-A.

राष्ट्रीय हस्तशिल्प विकास कार्यक्रम (एनएचडीपी) के तहत हस्तशिल्प क्षेत्र में उत्कृष्टता के लिए हस्तशिल्प कारीगरों और डिजाइनरों को हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार प्रदान किए जाते हैं।

उद्देश्य:

- हस्तशिल्प कारीगरों और डिजाइनरों के असाधारण कौशल को पहचानना जिन्होंने शिल्प परंपरा के संवर्धन, विकास एवं संरक्षण तथा शिल्पी समुदाय के कल्याण में अपना महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया हो।
- युवा कारीगरों को और अधिक जोश एवं उत्पादक पद्धति के साथ कार्य करने हेतु प्रोत्साहित करना और अन्यो को उनके साथ प्रतिस्पर्धा के लिए बढ़ावा देना।
- एकल व्यक्तियों/डिजाइनरों को हस्तशिल्प उत्पादों की मार्केटिंग के लिए अभिनव उपायों को अपनाने और उनकी उपलब्धियों को पहचान देने हेतु पुरस्कार प्रदान करना।

• विवरण

अभिनव डिजाइन के लिए राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कार राष्ट्रीय पुरस्कार का एक घटक है जो सह-सृजन के आधार पर डिजाइनरों और कारीगरों के एक समूह को प्रदान किया जाता है।

• पात्रता

पात्रता मानदंड निम्नलिखित हैं:

- i) सह-सृजन के आधार पर डिजाइनर और कारीगर के पास संबंधित शिल्प में वैध फोटो पहचान पत्र होना आवश्यक है। डिजाइनर के पास मूर्तिकला, ललित कला, डिजाइन, फैशन आदि (हस्तशिल्प के संदर्भ में) में किसी मान्यताप्राप्त संस्थान से 4 वर्ष की डिग्री होनी चाहिए। अभ्यर्थियों को अपनी शैक्षणिक योग्यता और अनुभव (यदि कोई हो) से संबंधित आवश्यक दस्तावेज़ प्रस्तुत करने आवश्यक है।
- ii) भारत के नागरिक और निवासी (30 वर्ष की आयु से अधिक)
- iii) हस्तशिल्प क्षेत्र में 10 वर्षों का अनुभव।

नामांकन द्वारा:

सम्मानित संगठन जैसे भारतीय केंद्रीय कुटीर उद्योग निगम लि. (सीसीआईसी), हस्तशिल्प निर्यात संवर्धन परिषद (ईपीसीएच), कालीन निर्यात संवर्धन परिषद (सीईपीसी), राष्ट्रीय फैशन टेक्नोलॉजी संस्थान (निफ़्ट), राष्ट्रीय डिजाइन संस्थान (एनआईडी), भारतीय शिल्प परिषद और हस्तशिल्प के क्षेत्र में कार्यरत केंद्रीय/राज्य/हस्तशिल्प निगम भी हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कारों के विचार हेतु नजदीकी हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र में आवेदनों की सिफ़ारिश कर सकती है।

(घ) स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम के लिए राष्ट्रीय हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार

विवरण:

यह पुरस्कार उस स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम को प्रदान किया जाएगा जो हस्तशिल्प क्षेत्र में विगत पाँच वर्षों से सतत आर्थिक प्रगति की ओर हस्तशिल्प उत्पादों के उत्पादन के लिए इको-सिस्टम बनाने और रोजगार के अवसर सृजित करने के लक्ष्य के साथ कार्य कर रहा हो। स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम द्वारा उद्यमिता विचारधारा को आगे बढ़ाने में संतोषजनक प्रगति की जानी चाहिए। स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम की विकास संबंधी उपलब्धियों के क्रम में रोजगार सृजन और हस्तशिल्प कामगारों के वेतन में वृद्धि पर विचार किया जाएगा। स्टार्ट-अप को इस संबंध में डीपीआईटी (वाणिज्य विभाग) के दिशानिर्देशों के प्रावधानों का अनुसरण करना होगा।

पात्रता:

स्टार्ट-अप की मौजूदगी की न्यूनतम अवधि गत वर्ष 31 दिसंबर को 05 वर्षों की होनी चाहिए। तथैपि, यह 10 वर्षों से अधिक पुरानी नहीं होनी चाहिए। उद्यम की चार्टर्ड एकाउंटेंट या सांविधिक लेखाकारों से सत्यापित पिछले 3 वर्षों के वित्तीय विवरण पर विचार किया जाएगा। उदाहरण के लिए; वर्ष 2021 की प्रविष्टि के लिए, वित्तीय वर्ष 2017, 2018 तथा 2019-20 के लेखापरीक्षित आंकड़ों पर विचार किया जाएगा।

स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम के लिए स्पॉट सत्यापन

हस्तशिल्प क्षेत्र में स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम की पात्रता तथा पिछले पाँच वर्षों में उसकी प्रगति की पुष्टि क्षेत्र के संबंधित क्षेत्रीय निदेशक द्वारा गठित समिति द्वारा स्पॉट सत्यापन के माध्यम से की जाएगी। तत्पश्चात संबंधित क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय द्वारा मुख्यालय स्तर चयन समिति के समक्ष रिपोर्ट प्रस्तुत की जाएगी।

- महिला हस्तशिल्प कारीगरों के लिए अनन्य रूप से पुरस्कारों का प्रावधान:
प्रत्येक शिल्प गुरु हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार (एसजीएचए) और राष्ट्रीय हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार (एनएचए) में से एक पुरस्कार विशिष्ट रूप से केवल महिला हस्तशिल्प कारीगरों को प्रदान किया जा सकता है।

- शिल्प कलाकृतियों को प्रस्तुत करना**

आवेदक प्रत्येक श्रेणी में नीचे दिए गए ब्यौरे अनुसार चयन हेतु पुरस्कार के लिए निर्मित कलाकृति को बनाने की शुरु से अंत तक द्विभाषी (अंग्रेजी एवं हिन्दी में) तकनीकी बारीकियों के साथ सभी संगत दस्तावेजों सहित नमूनों को आवेदन के साथ प्रस्तुत करेगा। कलाकृति बनाने की विधि की तकनीकी बारीकियों को हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र के अधिकारी द्वारा हस्ताक्षरित किया जाना अनिवार्य है।

शिल्प श्रेणी में दक्षता निर्धारित करने के लिए कौशल परीक्षण क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय/ संबंधित हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र द्वारा गठित समिति के समक्ष संचालित किया जाएगा। क्षेत्रीय स्तर चयन समिति को प्रविष्टियाँ भेजने से पूर्व परीक्षण या तो कारीगर के कार्यस्थल या हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र या किसी अन्य उपयुक्त स्थान पर विडियोग्राफी के साथ किया जा सकता है।

संबंधित हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र फील्ड अधिकारी द्वारा संचालित “मौके पर सत्यापन रिपोर्ट” प्रस्तुत करेगा। क्षेत्रीय स्तर पर कलाकृतियों को संस्तुत करने वाली फील्ड अधिकारियों की निरीक्षण रिपोर्ट के पूर्ण सत्यापन के लिए हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र स्तर पर एक जांच संबंधित क्षेत्रीय स्तर द्वारा संचालित की जाएगी। यह रिपोर्ट मुख्यालय स्तर चयन समिति के समक्ष प्रस्तुत की जाएगी।

पुरस्कार के सामान्य नियम और शर्तें

स्टार्ट-अप उद्यम के लिए राष्ट्रीय हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार (राष्ट्रीय हस्तशिल्प पुरस्कार की उप श्रेणी)	इस पुरस्कार में, 2.00 लाख रुपए का नकद पुरस्कार, एक ताम्रपत्र, शॉल और प्रमाणपत्र शामिल है।
डिज़ाइन नवाचार पुरस्कार	इस पुरस्कार में 3.00 लाख रुपए नकद पुरस्कार शामिल है जिसे संबंधित डिज़ाइनरों और कारीगरों के बीच बराबर बांटा जाता है तथा एक शॉल, एक प्रमाणपत्र और ताम्रपत्र डिज़ाइनर और कारीगर दोनों को प्रदान किया जाता है।

2. पुरस्कारकर्ता के चरित्र और पूर्ववृत्त का सत्यापन

क्षेत्र स्तरीय चयन समिति के समक्ष विचार हेतु आवेदन की अनुशंसा करने से पूर्व संबंधित एजेंसी के माध्यम से चरित्र एवं पूर्ववृत्त का सत्यापन हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र के वरिष्ठ सहायक निदेशक/सहायक निदेशक (ह.) द्वारा किया जाएगा। क्षेत्रीय निदेशक मुख्यालय कार्यालय को आवेदनों की अनुशंसा करने से पूर्व चरित्र और पूर्ववृत्त का सत्यापन सुनिश्चित करें अथवा यदि संबंधित प्राधिकरण से रिपोर्ट लंबित है तो एक प्रमाणपत्र दिया जा सकता है कि रिपोर्ट लंबित है और बाद में प्रेषित की जाएगी।

3. अपराधिक मामलों, परिवार के सदस्यों का विवरण/पहले पुरस्कृत हुए व्यक्तियों के नाम आदि के संबंध में आवेदक से घोषणा एक शपथपत्र पर निर्धारित प्रारूप में प्रस्तुत होना चाहिए जो श्रेणी 1 के केंद्र/राज्य सरकार के अधिकारी द्वारा सत्यापित और रबड़ की मोहर युक्त होनी चाहिए।

- उपरोक्त के अतिरिक्त, विकास आयुक्त (हस्तशिल्प) कार्यालय के पोर्टल www.handicrafts.nic.in द्वारा ऑनलाइन माध्यम से अथवा क्षेत्रीय कार्यालय और निकटतम हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र द्वारा ऑफलाइन माध्यम से भी आवेदन आमंत्रित किए जाएंगे।
- विकास आयुक्त (हस्तशिल्प) कार्यालय के क्षेत्रीय निदेशक द्वारा (हस्तशिल्प एवं फील्ड कार्यालय अर्थात् हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्रों) प्रत्येक फील्ड कार्यालय/हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्र, दिल्ली हाट, राष्ट्र स्तरीय मेलों आदि में स्थायी होर्डिंग्स के माध्यम से व्यापक प्रचार किया जाएगा तथा सभी हस्तशिल्प कलस्टरों और दिल्ली हाट के स्टोलों में पेंफलेट आवंटित किए जाएँ। बोर्ड/होर्डिंग्स और पेंफलेट में स्पष्ट रूप से पुरस्कार प्रविष्टियों को जमा करने की अंतिम तिथि और चयन के संक्षिप्त मानदंड के बारे में सूचित किया जाए।

- सभी हस्तशिल्प सेवा केंद्रों (एचएससी) को महिला कारीगरों को पुरस्कार के लिए आवेदन हेतु प्रेरित करने और सहायता देने के लिए विशेष अभियान चलाने की आवश्यकता है।

शिल्पकारिता की उत्कृष्टता की जांच शिल्प कलाकृतियों के शिल्प श्रेणी के अलग-अलग चरणों के कम से कम 4 फोटोग्राफों के साथ प्राप्त नमूनों से की जाएगी। उत्पाद बनाने के विभिन्न चरणों की फोटोग्राफी जमा की जानी चाहिए, यदि संभव हो।

हस्तशिल्प क्षेत्र में अन्य उपलब्धियों का मूल्यांकन शिल्प कलाकृतियों के विभिन्न चरणों की फोटोग्राफी सहित, जीवनवृत्त तथा उसमें प्रस्तुत किए गए दस्तावेजों से किया जाएगा।

शिल्प के विकास में नई खोज में सफलता प्राप्त करने हेतु किए गए प्रयासों पर उचित विचार किया जाएगा।

पुरस्कारों को अधिक समावेशी बनाने के लिए, पुरस्कार प्राप्त करने वाले परिवार के आवेदकों की तुलना में अन्य उत्कृष्ट कारीगरों पर उचित विचार किया जाए। यह प्रोत्साहन कौशल प्रसार एवं शिल्प परंपरा के संरक्षण में सहायक होगा।

- Reward individuals/designers to adopt innovative measures for marketing of Handicrafts products and recognize their achievements.
- Spread awareness about adoption of innovative Technology advancements in production of Handicrafts products by Artisans/ designer and their achievements in terms of increase in production.

Award Ceremony will be organized to give the awards to the awardees.

- While considering National Handicrafts Award for (1) exclusively for women artisan, (2) Young artisan below 30 years of age (3) Divyang artisan, (4) Endangered Craft and Tribal artisan under Craft Category, due consideration should be given for any noteworthy effort in terms of reviving the craft by product diversification or application of contemporary use.

c) National Handicrafts Award for Design Innovation

• Description

National Award for Design Innovation is a sub-category of National Awards and is given to a group of designers & artisans on a co-creation basis.

• Eligibility

Following are the eligible entity:

- i) On co-creation basis to designer and artisan having valid photo identity card under PAHCHAN in the respective craft. Designer should have 4 years Degree from recognized institutions in sculpture, fine arts, design, fashion etc. (with relevance to handicrafts). Candidates must submit necessary documents related to their educational qualification and experience (if any).
- ii) Citizens & residents of India (not below 30 years of age)
- iii) 10 years' experience in Handicrafts Sector.

By Nomination:

Reputed organizations viz. Central Cottage Industries Corporation of India Ltd (CCIC), Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts (EPCH) , Carpet Export Promotion Council (CEPC) , National Institute of Fashion Technology (NIFT) , National Institute of Design (NID), Crafts Council of India and Central/State /Handicrafts Corporations working in the field of handicrafts may also recommend the applicants for the Handicrafts Awards to the nearest Handicrafts Service Centre for consideration..

d) National Handicrafts Award for Start up Venture

Description

This award is given to the Start up venture which is working in the handicrafts sector with the aim to build eco system for production of handicrafts products to drive the sustainable economic growth for past five years and generate employment opportunities. The Start up venture should have made substantial progress to stir entrepreneurial spirit. The achievements in terms of growth of the start up venture, employment generation and increase in the wages of the handicrafts workers are to be considered. The start up must be compliant with the provisions of DPIT (Department of Commerce) guidelines on the subject.

Eligibility

The start-up should have been in existence for a minimum period of 05 years as on 31st December of the previous year. However, it should not be more than 10 years old. The financial statement of the last 3 years, of the venture duly certified by the Chartered Accountants or Statutory Auditors are to be considered. For example ; for an entry for award 2021, the audited figures for financial years 2017, 2018 and 2019-20 will be considered.

Spot Verification report for Start up Venture

Confirmation of eligible start-up venture in the handicrafts sector and its progress over a period of five years is done by the Spot Verification by the Committee constituted by the concerned Regional Director of the region. The report will be placed before the Headquarter level selection Committee by the Regional Office concerned.

Submission of Craft Artefacts

Applicants will submit the samples against each category as per details given below of the artifacts developed for the award for selection with technical details of processing method from starting to the finish product in bilingual (English & Hindi) along with application form with all the relevant documents. The technical details of the processing method should duly be signed by the Officer of Handicrafts Service Centre

- **Demonstration of Craft skill**

Skill test to determine proficiency in Craft Category will be conducted before a committee constituted by Regional Office / Handicrafts Service Centre concerned. The test will be conducted at either at working place of the artisan or at Handicrafts Service Centres (HSCs) or at any other suitable place along with the videography before recommending the entries to Regional Level Selection Committee.

Handicrafts Service Centre concerned will submit “**on the spot verification report**” conducted by the field officer. An inspection report of the field officers recommending the artefacts at the Regional level would be conducted by an inter Handicrafts Service Centre level for cross verification, is done by the concerned Regional Level. The report will be placed before the Headquarter level selection committee.

General Terms and Conditions of Awards

1. Award Contents

Shilp Guru Handicrafts Award	The award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 3.50 lakh, mounted gold coin (20 grams), tamrapatra, shawl and a certificate.
National Handicrafts Award (All categories)	This award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 2.00 lakh, tamrapatra, shawl and a certificate.
National Handicrafts Award for Start-up Venture (Sub category of National Handicrafts Award)	This award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 2.00 lakh, tamrapatra, shawl and a certificate.
Design Innovation Award	This award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 3.00 lakh to be shared equally between the concerned designer and the artisan, a shawl, a certificate and tamrapatra for both designer and artisan.

2. Verification of character & antecedent of the awardee

The verification of character & antecedent will be carried out by the Sr. Assistant Director /Asstt. Director (H) of Handicrafts Service Centre through the concerned agency before recommending the application to Regional Level Selection Committee for consideration. Regional Director may ascertain of verification of the character antecedent before recommending the applications to Headquarter office or if the report is awaited from the concerned authority, a certificate may be given that the report is awaited and would be forwarded later on.

3. Declaration from the applicant regarding criminal cases, details of members of the family/ persons who have been awarded earlier, etc should be submitted in the prescribed format on an affidavit form duly attested by Class 1 officer of Central/State Govt. affixing the rubber stamp.

4. Procedures of advertisement & publicity for entries:

- An advertisement would be published in the important national/regional newspapers in Hindi, English and vernacular languages by the Office of DC (Handicrafts). The notification along with Awards calendar will also be uploaded on the website of office of Development Commissioner (Handicrafts) viz www.handicrafts.nic.in
- Besides above, applications will be invited through online mode the portal of DC(HC) Office viz www.haandicrafts.nic.in or offline mode through Regional Offices and nearest Handicrafts Service Centre.

- Wide publicity shall be given by the Regional Director of Office of Development Commissioner (Handicrafts and field office i.e. Handicrafts Service Centres through permanent hoardings at each field office/Handicrafts Service Centre, Dilli Haat, National Level Melas, etc. and pamphlets may be distributed in all Handicrafts clusters and the stalls at Dilli Haat. The boards/hoardings and pamphlets may clearly indicate the last date for submission of award entries and brief criteria of selection.
- District Collectors/Magistrate/District Industries Centres/Block Development Officers /Panchayat and DRDA may be requested by the concerned Handicrafts Service Centres to make publicity at their level.
- Regional Directors and Handicrafts Service Centres shall hold exclusive meetings with Artisans' representatives of Artisans' associations for spreading awareness about the award scheme.
- Special mention may be made in the meetings/Workshops/seminars/ symposia/ interaction sessions etc., by the Regional Directors and Handicrafts Service Centres about the award scheme.
- All Handicrafts Service Centres (HSCs) are required to make special drive to motivate and assist women Artisans for applying for the awards.

6. Procedure for submission of entries

- All eligible applicants may submit their applications online / offline in the format as per Annexure –as applicable, whenever a notification is advertised in the important national/regional newspapers by the Office of DC (Handicrafts). They will submit the signed copy of printout of the online application mode, the craft artefacts and relevant documents, etc. to the nearest Handicrafts Service Centres.
- Joint entry may be accepted only in case of Craft Category in Design Innovation in National Handicrafts Award. In other craft categories **no, joint entry would be accepted.**
- All entries submitted by the applicant along with their crafts (where ever applicable) must be supported with declarations stating that the item being submitted has been prepared by him/ her and he/she is submitting the entry at his/her own risk and in case of damage, etc. during transportation of the entry due to unforeseen circumstances, the Central Government will not be liable to pay any compensation.
- Applicants should attach photos of samples (where ever applicable) of final product as well as photos taken during intermittent stages of the product making, or videography of the intermittent stages of the product making with applications.
- All the pages of application along with photos of sample/other documents will be numbered serially as X/Y (X is serial page number and Y is total number of pages). All pages/photos/documents should be signed/attested by the applicant and countersigned by the concerned Regional Director /Deputy Director /Sr. Assistant Director /Assistant Director.

- In the cases where applicant has already been conferred award in a particular category earlier, he/she cannot apply in the same category again e.g. National Award. However, he/she may apply for award in any other category as per eligibility e.g. Shilp Guru.
- All sponsored entries by the Central / State corporation / voluntary organizations working in the field will be sent to the nearest Handicrafts Service Centres of Office of the Development Commissioner (Handicrafts) for recommendation to the Regional Level Selection Committee within stipulated time.

7. Processing of applications

- The concerned Handicrafts Service Centre will carry out proper scrutiny of applications, conduct skill/proficiency test (demonstration of Craft Category skills) and then recommend eligible entries for the Regional Level Selection Committee. Handicrafts Service Centres will exercise due diligence to physically verify the bona-fides of the applicants and verification of the character antecedents from the concerned agency..
- One officer of the rank of Dy. Director/Assistant Director from Regional office will be nominated for coding of craft artefacts. After coding, applications will be sealed separately, codes will be stitched to samples and all other identification marks will be removed /masked properly so that identity of Artisans is not known.

- Samples will be coded for Shilp Guru and National Award in following format :-

, Coding list (without names) and samples will be submitted to the Regional Level Selection committees.

- Minutes of all Regional Level Selection Committee meetings along with applications and samples etc. will be sent to the DC (Handicrafts), HQs, New Delhi in sealed cover for organizing HQ and Central Level Selection Committee meetings.
- One officer of the rank of Regional Director level from the office of DC (HC) will be nominated to personally code the samples again. Samples will be coded with prefix CLSC followed by SGHA/NHA, year of the award followed by 3 digits. Products of the same category will be in the serial order. The code should not reflect Area/District/nomenclature of products/name of the artisan, etc.
- The write up attached to samples during exhibits should contain all technical aspects of the product from beginning to end of the product in bilingual (Hindi and English) and should be certified by the concerned officer of field office of Handicrafts Service Centre who had undertaken the inspection of the artifacts.

8. Selection Process:

There is a three-tier system for selection of Handicrafts Award. The composition of the members of each Selection Committees is as under. The final selection of the awards for conferring is by Central Level Selection Committee (Level -3) under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Textiles) :

Sir,

As aware, this office implements various schemes for promotion and development of Handicrafts sector under "National Handicrafts Development Programme (NHDP)" and "Comprehensive Handicrafts Cluster Development Scheme (CHCDS)". Presently, PAHCHAN ID cards are being issued to handicrafts artisans throughout the country in 72 Craft categories since 2016 in order to avail the scheme benefits.

However, many oversights/discrepancies observed in the existing list of 72 categories such as bifurcation of crafts, repetitive categories mentioned in the list etc. Also, there is a miscellaneous category in which large number of ID cards have been issued without specifying name of the crafts.

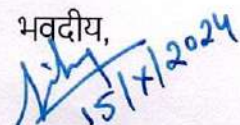
In order to cover all the crafts practiced across the country and overcome above difficulties, with the approval of competent authority, existing craft categories have been classified into 9 main categories & 36 subcategories covering 455 crafts. The details are as given below and annexed at 'Annexure - I':
