

AGREEMENT FOR LOAN

AN AGREEMENT made the _____ day of _____, 200__ between the President of India (hereinafter called "The Grantor" which expression where the context so admits shall include his successors in office and assigns) of the one part AND Handloom Cooperative Industrial (Production) Society Ltd., resident of _____ (hereinafter called "The Grantee", which expression where the context so admits shall include their / his / her / its heirs, executors, administrators representative and permitted assigned / successor(s) of other part.

WHEREAS the President of India has sanctioned a loan of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only) to the Grantee (payable in the instalments specified in the Schedule hereto) for the purpose of utilizing of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only) for advance for purchase / modernization / Renovation of looms to be paid in 10 (Ten) equal INSTALMENTS commencing from the First anniversary of the date of drawal on the conditions laid down in Rules regulating grants to assist small scale industrial undertakings in Delhi State, as per Annexure 'A'.

AND WHEREAS under the aforesaid rules of the Grantee is required to execute an agreement.

NOW, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows :-

1. This Grantor shall grant to the Grantee loan of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only).
2. In consideration of the loan granted to the Grantee by the Grantor as aforesaid (which loan shall hereinafter be referred to as the said grant) the Grantee hereby convenants with the Grantor as follows:-
 - (i) That the Grantee will abide by and carry out all the Rules regulating the grant of loans and all subsequent amendments thereafter additions therein (hereinafter called the Rules) and any condition imposed by the order sanctioning the grant.
 - (ii) That the Grantee will spend and utilize the said grant for the purpose for which it is granted within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the grant.

OR

That the Grantee will spend and utilize every instalment of the said grant for the purpose for which it is granted under the rules before the next instalment falls due failing which the Grantor may withhold the payment of any instalments.

- (iii) That the Grantee will apply the said grant solely for the purpose for which it is given and not for any other purpose except with the previous consent in writing of the Delhi Government, Delhi.

- (iv) That the said grant will bear interest @ _____ per cent per annum from the date of disbursement. The Grantee will repay the said grant with interest by equal annual instalments of Rs. _____ each falling due on the date specified below :

Rate of Interest will be charged as under :

- (a) Normal rate _____
- (b) Rebate of prompt Repayment/Interest payments _____
- (c) Penal rate of interest in the event of defaults in repayment / interest payment _____
- (d) Mode of recovery of interest 10 (Ten) in annual instalments, along with the Principal.

Such annual payments will be made at the Treasury of Delhi District and the receipt obtained thereof from the Treasury Office be presented to the Director of Industries for record.

- (v) That the Grantee will comply with general or special orders of the Grantor relating to the inspection of premises, building, plant, or stock in trade purchase out of the grant or constructed therewith.
- (vi) That the Grant will maintain accounts in the manner prescribed by the Grantor and will submit the accounts to such audit as may be prescribed by the Grantor.
- (vii) That the Grantee will furnish within such time as may be fixed by Grantor statements returns and reports prescribed by the Grantor relating to all the products manufactured and sold by him as regards description and quantity.
- (viii) That the Grantee will make such provision for the training of apprentices as may be prescribed by the Grantor.
- (ix) That the Grantee will not appropriate as profits of the industrial undertaking for which the said grant has been made until after the following sums have been paid :-
 - (a) An amount considered reasonable by the Grantor for depreciation or obsolescence of plants and buildings.
 - (b) An amount not less than 25% of the net surplus available after provision for depreciation or obsolescence to be utilized for payment to a sinking fund and for the purpose of repayment of the said grant; and,
 - (c) The interest due on the said grant according to the rate prescribed therefor.

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- (x) That the Grantee will not sell, mortgage or otherwise alienate change or assign the tools and machinery, without the previous sanction in writing of the Grantor.
- (xi) The Grantee will keep the machinery purchased and buildings etc. erected with the grant referred to above in good working conditions and will carry out the repairs and renewals as directed by the Grantor from time to time without undue delay at his own cost, and will get them insured against loss by fire, accident, theft etc.

3. Provided always and it is hereby agreed that in any of the following cases namely

- (a) When the Grantee commits a breach of any of the covenants herein contained or fails to fulfil any other conditions that may have been laid down by the Grantor.
- (b) When the Grantee fails to take sufficient measures to safeguard the plant, machinery, etc. from loss by fire, accidents, through an insurance policy for the same or to maintain the same in an efficient condition.
- (c) When any portion of the aid given has been misapplied
- (d) When the application on which the aid has been granted contained or was accompanied by any material statement by the owner which he knew to be false or any intentional concealment by him of any material fact which, to the Delhi Administration it was his duty to disclose
- (e) When industry is being managed in such a manner as to endanger the repayment of the value of State Aid granted thereto it shall be lawful for the Grantor to terminate the said grant or portion of the grant as the case may be at once without any notice and to recover the amount due thereunder with costs of recovery as arrears of land revenue.

4. And it is hereby further agreed between the parties that the stamp duty payable under law in respect of this agreement shall be borne by the Grantee.

5. All disputes and differences arising out of or in any wise touching or concerning his indenture (except these the decision whereof is otherwise hereinbefore provided for) shall be referred to the sole arbitration or any person nominated by the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi or in case his designation is changed at his office is abolished, to the sole arbitration of any person nominated by the officer who for the time being is entrusted, whether or not in addition to other functions, with functions of the Lt. Governor of Delhi, by whatever designation such officer may be called, it will be no objection to any such appointment that the arbitrator so appointed is a government servant that he had to deal with the matters to which this indenture relates and that in the course of his duties as such government servant he has expressed views on all or any of the matter in dispute or difference. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties.

AN AGREEMENT made the _____ day of _____, 200__ between the President of India (hereinafter called "The Grantor" which expression where the context so admits shall include his successors in office and assigns) of the one part AND _____ Handloom Cooperative Industrial (Production) Society Ltd., resident of _____ (hereinafter called "The Grantee", which expression where the context so admits shall include their / his / her / its heirs, executors, administrators representative and permitted assigned / successor(s) of other part.

WHEREAS the President of India has sanctioned a grant of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only) to the Grantee for the following purpose of the conditions laid down in Rules regulating grants to assist the Handloom industry from the cess, fund as per Annexure 'A'.

NOW, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH as follows :-

1. This Grantor shall grant to the Grantee a Grant in aid of Rs. _____ (Rupees _____ only).
2. In consideration of the grant in aid granted to the Grantee by the Grantor as aforesaid (which grant in aid shall hereinafter to refund to as the said grant) the Grantee hereby covenants with the Grantor as follows :
 - (i) That the Grantee will abide by and carry out all the Rules regulating the grant and all subsequent amendments thereof for additions therein (hereinafter called the Rules) and any condition imposed by the order sanctioning the grant.
 - (ii) That the Grantee will spend and utilize the said grant for the purpose for which it is granted within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the grant.
 - (iii) That the Grantee will apply the said grant solely for the purpose for which it is given and not for any other purpose except with the previous consent in writing of the Delhi Government, Delhi.
 - (iv) That the Grant will maintain accounts in the manner prescribed by the Grantor and will submit the accounts to such audit as may be prescribed by the Grantor.
 - (v) That the Grantee will comply with general or special orders of the Grantor relating to the inspection of premises, building, plant, or stock in trade purchase out of the constructed therewith.
 - (vi) That the Grantee will furnish within such time as may be fixed by Grantor statements returns and reports prescribed by the Grantor relating to all the products manufactured and sold by them as regards description and quantity.

- (vii) That the Grantee will make such provision for the training of apprentices as may be prescribed by the Grantor.
- (viii) That the Grantee will not sell, mortgage or otherwise alienate change or assign the tools and machinery, without the previous sanction in writing of the Grantor.
- (ix) The Grantee will keep the machinery equipment purchased with the grant referred to above in good working conditions and will carry out the repairs and renewals as directed by the Grant from time to time without undue delay at his own cost.

3. PROVIDED ALWAYS and it is hereby agreed that in any of the following cases namely:

- a) When the Grantee commits a breach of any of the covenants herein contained, or fails to fulfil any other conditions that may have been laid down by the Grantor.
- b) When any portion of the aid given has been misapplied.
- c) When the application on which the aid has been granted contained or was accompanied by any material statement by the owner which he knew to be false or any intentional concealment by him of any material fact which, in the opinion of the State Government, it was his duty to disclose.
- d) It shall be lawful for the Grantor to recover the said grant, at once without any notice with costs of recovery as arrears of land revenue.

4. AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER AGREED between the parties that the stamp duties payable under the law in respect of this agreement shall be borne by the Grantee.

5. All disputes and differences arising out of or in any wise touching or concerning this indenture (except these the decision whereof is otherwise hereinbefore provided for) shall be referred to the sole arbitration or any person nominated by the Lieutenant Governor of Delhi or in case his designation is changed at his office is abolished, to the sole arbitration of any person nominated by the officer who for the time being is entrusted, whether or not in addition to other functions, with functions of the Lt. Governor of Delhi, by whatever designation such officer may be called, it will be no objection to any such appointment that the arbitrator so appointed is a government servant that he had to deal with the matters to which this indenture relates and that in the course of his duties as such government servant he has expressed views on all or any of the matter in dispute or difference. The award of the arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding on the parties.
